



Information of Poster Paper Presentation

Poster sessions are a good medium for authors to present papers and meet with interested attendees for in-depth technical discussions. It is important that you display your message clearly and noticeably to attract people who might have an interest in your paper.

Your poster should cover the key points of your work. It need not, and should not, attempt to include all the details; you can describe them in person to people who are interested. The ideal poster is designed to attract attention, provide a brief overview of your work, and initiate discussion. Carefully and completely prepare your poster well in advance of the conference. Try tacking up the poster before you leave for the conference to see what it will look like and to make sure that you have all of the necessary pieces.

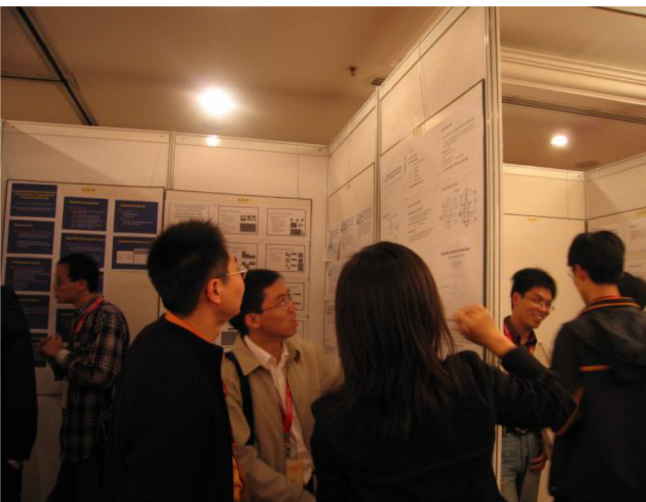
Besides 4-page manuscript will be printed in the Proceedings, the author of each accepted poster paper is requested to prepare poster material which will be put up on a board with **100cm width and 120cm height** at the designated time and place.

The title of your poster should appear at the top in CAPITAL letters. Below the title put the author(s)' name(s) and affiliation(s). Use color for highlighting and to make your poster more attractive. Use pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures, etc., rather than text wherever possible. The important points should be in a larger size in order to let people look at the posters clearly.

The concrete location and time to put up your posters, please keep an eye on the information in the notification in conference venue.
